Rules – The regatta will be governed by the rules defined in the current racing rules of US Sailing 2005-2008. The official notice board is the chalkboard at the entry of the clubhouse.

There will be three courses. The north course will be for all Opti classes. The center course will be for the 420 and CFJ classes . The south course will be for Thistles, Lasers, and Laser Radials.

Courses and Class Flags – All classes excluding Optis

Thistle	White-Thistle Flag
Laser	White-Laser Flag
Laser Radial	White-Laser Radial Flag
420	White-420 Flag
CFJ	White-Junior Flag
Opti Green Fleet	Green Flag
Opti Gold Fleet	Gold Flag

Course A-Board with letter A – windward-leeward with a start/finish line in the center of the course. The course will be sailed once or twice around. Once around indicated by a number one and twice around indicated by a number two displayed on the committee boat.

Course B-Board with letter B – once around, a triangle - windward-leeward-windward course with the start/finish line in the center of the course.

Opti class will always sail a triangle. The course will be sailed once or twice around. Once around indicated by a number one and twice around indicated by a number two displayed on the committee boat.

The start/finish line may only be crossed when starting and finishing. All marks to port.

There will be one throw out if 5 or more races are completed.

Starting – All classes will start using Race Rule 26. The starting line will be between a starting mark and the orange flag on the race committee boat.

General Recalls – Classes restarting will continue in their original starting sequence.

Protests shall be delivered to the race chairman in the clubhouse 30 minutes after the race committee docks. The protest will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held in the clubhouse as soon as possible. The protesting boat shall notify the R/C Boat immediately after it has finished the affected race of it's intent to protest.
